PURPOSE

This notification advises all aircraft owners, operators, manufacturers, maintenance organizations, parts suppliers, and distributors that the referenced articles manufactured or sold by *MadeByMike3D* may not meet FAA production approval.

BACKGROUND

Information discovered during an FAA Suspected Unapproved Parts (SUP) investigation revealed that between May 2024 and August 2025, Michael Graham, doing business as *MadebyMike3D*, produced and sold articles for installation on type-certificated aircraft without approval and authorization from the FAA.

The articles produced or sold by Michael Graham (or *MadeByMike3D*) may have these characteristics:

- Listed on Etsy.com point of sale website.
- No evidence indicating the articles were produced by an FAA-approved manufacturer.
- Articles are not marked in accordance with section 45.15 of Title 14, Code of Federal Regulations.

RECOMMENDATIONS

FAA regulations require that type-certificated products conform to their type design. The FAA encourages aircraft owners, operators, manufacturers, maintenance organizations, and parts suppliers and distributors to inspect their aircraft and/or aircraft parts inventory for the referenced articles. If these articles are found in existing inventory, the FAA recommends that they be quarantined to prevent installation until a determination can be made regarding their eligibility for installation.
