The certification basis of the Firefly 10 is FAR 31 effective July 1 1964 through amendment 31-2 effective April 12 1965.

This is an acceptable certification basis in accordance with NZCAR Part 21B Para §21.41. There are no non-compliances listed on the TCDS and no special conditions have been prescribed by the Director under 21.23.
