

Aerodrome Conditional Determination

Aerodrome Proposal, Tasman District Council, Takaka Aerodrome

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 157 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Head of Aeronautical Services, having received from Tasman District Council Notices of Aerodrome Proposal, conducted an Aeronautical Study in consultation with such persons, representative groups and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the Aeronautical Study I am satisfied that the proposed action will not affect the safe and efficient use of airspace but may adversely affect the safety of persons or property on the ground.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

CONDITIONAL DETERMINATION

in respect of the Notice of Proposal. The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The aerodrome operator should, in collaboration with aerodrome users, develop a Method of Work Plan (or equivalent) for the proposed works.
- The aerodrome operator must eliminate or minimise risks associated with the alterations so far as is reasonably practicable.
- The aerodrome operator should review the guidance material regarding obstacle limitation surfaces in AC139-7 and undertake an obstacle management process as required.
- The aerodrome operator should review AC139-8 to ensure that helicopter operations are conducted safely at the aerodrome.

The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder

This Conditional Determination shall become void on 1 September 2026.
