

Aerodrome Conditional Determination

Aerodrome Proposal, Fox Glacier Aerodrome

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 157 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from South Westland Pastoral Ltd a Notice of Aerodrome Proposal, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representative groups and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study I am satisfied that the proposed action will adversely affect existing aerodrome traffic circuits, the safe and efficient use of airspace, safety of persons or property on the ground, and there is an effect that man-made or natural objects have on operations within the affected area.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

CONDITIONAL DETERMINATION

in respect of the Notice of Proposal. The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. South Westland Pastoral Ltd must advise the Mount Cook and Westland National Parks User Group on the proposed aerodrome and heliport alteration, including arrival and departure procedures for helicopter and fixed wing operations. These procedures must be included in the Operations Handbook, which is to be provided to CAA for comment prior to the commencement of new operations at Fox aerodrome;
2. South Westland Pastoral Ltd is to publish Fox aerodrome and heliport data in the AIPNZ in accordance with AC139-9. The aerodrome operator is responsible for ensuring the AIPNZ is updated to contain all information relevant to procedures for air operations at the aerodrome and within the Southern Alps MBZ;
3. All operators using Fox aerodrome and heliport must comply with the agreed procedures contained in both the AIPNZ and the Mount Cook and Westland National Parks Aircraft Users Group Operations Handbook;
4. South Westland Pastoral Ltd must develop TLOF, FATO, arrival and departure sectors for the heliports, and provide the information on these to CAA prior to the commencement of operations;
5. Westland Pastoral Ltd is to ensure the design and layout of Fox aerodrome and heliport complies with standard design requirements provided in both AC139-7- Aerodrome Standards and Requirements, and AC139-8 – Heliports.

The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder

6. In addition to the design requirements provided in AC139-7 and AC139-8, South Westland Pastoral Ltd is to install fencing with signage around the perimeter of all operational areas of the aerodrome, and also a Windssock within the aerodrome boundary.
7. South Westland Pastoral Ltd is to provide CAA with an annual report of traffic movement data at Fox aerodrome, in accordance with CAR Part 139.505 (a).

This conditional determination shall become void on 1st day of June 2019.
