

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Hawkins Construction Ltd Tower Cranes for New Engineering Building Auckland University, Grafton Street Auckland.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Hawkins Construction Ltd, notification of intention to construct and operate tower cranes at the University of Auckland Engineering campus on Grafton Street, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

To mitigate some unforeseen hazard that does not meet the standards set out in Civil Aviation Rule Part 77 to be called Hazard, the following conditions are specific to the Determination:

- 1. The cranes at the site must each be equipped with a flashing red light located at the highest available point on each crane, in accordance with CAR Part 77, Appendix B. These lights must be operational at all times; and
- 2. The proponent is to notify the CAA that the operation has ceased, as soon as possible after the cranes have been dismantled.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 16th day of October 2017 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 19th day of March 2019.
