

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Canyon Adventures Limited- Cable Mounted Bungy Jump Box Queenstown

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Murray John Porter, Acting Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Canyon Adventures Limited, notification of intention to construct and operate a cable mounted bungy jump across Rees Valley, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

• Canyon Adventures must provide CAA, Aeronautical Services Unit, with at least five days' notice prior to the commencement of construction so that a NOTAM can be raised and action initiated to publish the operation on aeronautical charts.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 9<sup>th</sup> day of April 2015 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 12<sup>th</sup> day of September 2016.
