

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Canyon Adventures Limited- Cable Mounted Bungy Jump Box Queenstown

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Murray John Porter, Acting Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Canyon Adventures Limited, notification of intention to construct and operate a cable mounted bungy jump across Rees Valley, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- Canyon Adventures must provide CAA, Aeronautical Services Unit, with at least five days' notice prior to the commencement of construction so that a NOTAM can be raised and action initiated to publish the operation on aeronautical charts.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 9th day of April 2015 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 12th day of September 2016.
