

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Armstrong Downes Commercial 2012 Ltd, Concrete Pump at 300 Kapiti Road Paraparaumu

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Armstrong Downes Commercial 2012 Ltd, notification of intention to operate a 10 metre high (AGL) crane at a construction site on Kapiti Rd, Paraparaumu, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The concrete pump must be fitted with obstacle lighting in accordance with CAR Part 77, Appendix B; and
- The operator of the Concrete pump must be in constant radio communication with the Airways Flight information Service at Paraparaumu to allow emergency lowering of the concrete pump; and
- The Operator of the concrete pump must abide by the conditions specified by Kapiti Coast Airport Holdings Ltd, and any additional future conditions that are imposed during the execution of the project; and
- 4. The CAA must be notified of the removal of the concrete pump at the end of the project.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 14 October 2018 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall expire on 2nd February 2019.
