

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Watercare Services Ltd Construct Water Supply Tanks Pukekohe

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Watercare Services Ltd, notification of intention to construct two water supply tanks at the corner of Runciman Road and Rutherford Road, Pukekohe East, in the vicinity of a private airstrip at 97 Runciman Road, Pukekohe East, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

This Determination revokes all previous Determinations issued for the proposed construction of this water reservoir.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The aerodrome operator and the CAA must be provided with a minimum of 90 days' notice of the commencement of construction of the tanks; and
- 2. The operator of the Pukekohe East airstrip should provide advice to aircraft operators using the airstrip, regarding the presence of the water tanks and any other local operating procedures required to ensure safe aircraft operations at the airstrip.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on the 6^{th} day of May 2016 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
