

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Shell Todd Oil Services Ltd Three Legged Jack Up Rig 7.5 Nautical Miles North East of New Plymouth Aerodrome

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Christopher Martin Ford, General Manager Aviation Infrastructure and Personnel, having received from Shell Todd Oil Services Ltd, notification of intention to operate a 124 metre high, three legged jack up rig in the North Taranaki Bight, 7.5 nautical miles north east of New Plymouth aerodrome, and within promulgated danger area NZD 325, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 20th day of October 2015 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
