

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Fulton Hogan Limited - Increase in Boom Length of 180E Crawler Crane

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Fulton Hogan Limited, notification of intention to operate an 80 metre high crawler crane at Huntly, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The crane is to be equipped with a flashing red light at the highest possible point of the crane; and
- The CAA must be notified of the completion of the crane operation at the site within 5 days of its removal.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April 2017 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 15<sup>th</sup> day of September 2018.
