

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 1 Tod Street, Castlecliff, Whanganui.

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Head of Aeronautical Services, having received from Whanganui Port Limited Partnership, notification of intention to continue to operate a crane at 1 Tod Street, Castlecliff, Whanganui, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is not to exceed 45m above ground level (AGL); and
2. Whanganui Port Limited Partnership is to maintain the procedure of lowering the crane at night; and
3. Whanganui Port Limited Partnership is to continue to have a current Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) issued for the awareness of aviation until the crane is lowered and no longer in use; and
4. Whanganui Port Limited Partnership is to advise the CAA (Quote 2025-01517 to aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane is lowered and no longer in use.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 12th December 2025 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 27th June 2027.
