

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Smith Cranes Limited- Amended Crane Operations at 3 Scott Rd, Hobsonville

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Smith Cranes Limited, notification of intention to operate additional cranes at 3 Scott Road, Hobsonville, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1) The existing Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) for this site is to be amended to stipulate individual crane heights; and
- 2) Crane Jib and Mid boom obstruction lights to be fitted and illuminated at all times; and
- 3) Crane operations are not to exceed 75m AMSL; and
- 4) Smith Cranes are to notify Whenuapai Base Operations (AKBASEOPERATIONS@NZDF.MIL.NZ 09 4177442) when crane operations commence and;
- 5) Smith Cranes are to notify Whenuapai Base Operations and CAA when crane operations cease in total and the crane is removed off site.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 29 September 2020 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 31 December 2021.
