

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION:

Titan Cranes Ltd – 292 Main South Road, Hornby, Christchurch.

Position: 43 32 31.20 S 172 32 14.58 E

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Hamish William McKoy, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Titan Cranes Ltd, notification of intention to operate a 78m high crane at 292 Main South Road, Hornby, Christchurch, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The tower crane at 292 Main South Road, Hornby, Christchurch is to be lit as proposed by Titan Cranes Ltd in their application Section 3 (c); and
- 2. The crane is not to exceed 104m AMSL; and
- 3. The crane will be operated during daylight hours only, and
- 4. Titan Cranes Ltd is to advise CAA (Quote 24/77/59 aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane at the 292 Main South Road, Hornby, Christchurch site is removed.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 25 July 2024 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 10 June 2025.
