



## **NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Lower Queen Street, Richmond, Tasman 41 19 39 S 173 10 17 E**

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Fulton Hogan, notification of intention to operate a crane at Lower Queen Street, Richmond, Tasman from October 2024 until 31<sup>st</sup> of December 2025, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

### DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is to be lit as proposed by Fulton Hogan in their application Section 3 (c); and
2. The Crane is not to exceed a height of 68m above mean sea level (AMSL); and
3. Fulton Hogan is to contact Nelson Airport, Operations Manager (email [jesse@nelsonairport.co.nz](mailto:jesse@nelsonairport.co.nz)) to notify the crane location and height; and
4. Fulton Hogan is to contact Nelson Airport to advise when the crane is lowered and no longer in use.
5. Fulton Hogan is to advise CAA (Quote 25/77/13) [aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz](mailto:aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane operating at Lower Queen Street is lowered and no longer in use.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 1<sup>st</sup> of November 2024 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

*The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder*

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 4<sup>th</sup> of April 2026
