



NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION:

Titan Cranes Ltd. - 292 Main South Road, Hornby, Christchurch. Position: 43 32 31.22 S 172 32 14.60 E

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Nicholas George John Jackson, Team Leader Aeronautical Services, having received from Titan Cranes Ltd., notification of intention to continue to operate an 84m high crane at 292 Main South Road, Hornby, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is to be lit as stated in Section 3(c) of the proposal and
2. The crane height is not to exceed 84m AGL; and
3. At least 90 days prior to the expiry of this No Hazard determination, Titan Cranes Ltd. is to re-apply for a new determination noting a previous assessment reference 2026-00415.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 6th August 2026 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 15th November 2027
