

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Moa Point Sewage Treatment Plant, Stewart Duff Drive, Wellington Position 42 20 05.52 S 174 48 37.02 E

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Wellington City Council, notification of a change to the position and height of one of two cranes previously notified at this site, conducted a further aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing this aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The cranes are to be lit with appropriate obstacle lighting as stated in the proposal; and
- 2. The cranes are not to exceed a height of 44.3m AMSL; and
- 3. Wellington City Council is to advise CAA (Quote 24/77/60 <a href="mailto:aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz">aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz</a>) when the cranes are finally lowered and no longer in use at the Stewart Duff Drive site.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 28 June 2024 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 31st December 2025
