

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Crane at 2 Park Road, Grafton Auckland.

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from McConnell Dowell Constructors Limited, notification of intention to operate a crane at 2 Park Road, Grafton, Auckland conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is to be lit with an appropriate obstacle light in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B; and
2. As already stated by Aeropath, the AIP charts are to be amended accordingly to alert aviators for the Auckland Hospital (NZJL) Heliport of the erection of the crane; and
3. McConnell Dowell Constructors Limited is to advise Northland Rescue Helicopters (NEST) when the crane is lowered and no longer in use; and
4. McConnell Dowell Constructors Limited is to advise the CAA (Quote 23/77/03) (aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane operating at the Park Road site is lowered and no longer in use; and
5. McConnell Dowell Constructors Limited is to advise the Airways NOTAM Office (03-358 1688) when the crane is lowered and no longer in use so that the NOTAM can be cancelled; and
6. McConnell Dowell Constructors Limited is to advise the Aeropath (Quote 23/77/03 ADHB, 2 Park Road, Grafton, Auckland – info@aeropath.aero) when the crane is lowered and no longer in use so that the AIP procedures can be restored to normal.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 21st October 2022 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
