

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Building at Waikato Hospital Campus, Pembroke Street, Hamilton.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Te Whatu Ora – Waikato Hospital, notification of intention to erect a building at Waikato Hospital Campus, Pembroke Street, Hamilton, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. Te Whatu Ora Waikato Hospital is to liaise directly with search and rescue services limited (SRSL) for an agreed lighting plan for the building; and
- 2. When construction commences, Te Whatu Ora Waikato Hospital is to notify Aeropath (Quote 23/77/15 Attention Phil Bickerton info@aeropath.aero) and request the building footprint is depicted on the appropriate aeronautical chart.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 6th January 2023 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 6th July 2024.
