

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: North Shore Hospital, Takapuna – 6 month Extension

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Hawkins Construction Limited notification to operate two cranes at North Shore Hospital, Takapuna, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane shall be lit with an appropriate obstacle light and boom light in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B, and
2. Hawkins Construction Limited shall contact Aeropath (<https://www.aeropath.aero/>) Att: Phil Bickerton, when the crane operation is no longer required so that the necessary AIP charts can be adjusted; and
3. Hawkins Construction Limited shall advise the CAA, (Quote 21/77/21 – aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane operating at the North Shore Hospital site is no longer required.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 14th October 2022 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 14th April 2023.
