

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 38 Oxford Terrace, Christchurch.

Location: 43 32 06.08 S 172 37 48.37 E

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Head of Aeronautical Services, having received from Platform Construction Limited, notification of intention to operate a crane at 38 Oxford Terrace, Christchurch, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is not to exceed 70m above ground level (AGL); and
2. Prior to the disassembly phase of duration 3 days, scheduled for mid-2028, Platform Construction Limited is to liaise with CH DHB to enquire if there are any concerns for the crane operation conflicting with the hospital helipad; and
3. Platform Construction Limited is to advise the CAA (Quote 2026-00161 to aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the disassembly phase is completed.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 6th May 2026 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 8th October 2027.
