

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 5 Mile Shopping Centre, Frankton, Queenstown. Location: 45 00 50.09 S, 168 44 34.15 E

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Nicholas George John Jackson, Team Leader Aeronautical Services, having received from Naylor Love South Limited, notification of intention to operate a crane at 5 Mile Shopping Centre, Frankton, Queenstown, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is not to exceed 38.1 m above ground level (AGL); and
2. Lighting to be fitted at the discretion of the crane operator, as stated in the proposal; and
3. When the crane is lowered and no longer in use, Naylor Love South Limited is to advise the CAA (Quote 2026-00787 to aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz); and
4. If an extension is required, at least one month prior to the expiry of this determination, Naylor Love South Limited is to contact CAA to request an extension (Quote 2026-00787 to aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz).

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 27th July 2026 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 3rd January 2028.
