

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 70 Westpoint Drive, Hobsonville, Auckland. Location: 36 48 35.87 S 174 37 52.15 E

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Head of Aeronautical Services, having received from Waide Commercial Construction Limited, notification to operate several cranes at 70 Westpoint Drive, Hobsonville, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The cranes are to be lit in accordance with CAR Part 77, Appendix B and as agreed with RNZAF Base Operations, Whenuapai; and
2. The height of the crane operations is not to exceed 65m above ground level (AGL); and
3. Prior to the proposed crane operation, Waide Commercial Construction Limited is to agree on an operations plan with RNZAF Base Operations at Whenuapai to include the issue of a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) for each period of operation; and
4. When the cranes are lowered and no longer in use, Waide Commercial Construction Limited is to ensure this is communicated to RNZAF Base Operations at Whenuapai so that any active NOTAM can be cancelled; and
5. When the cranes are lowered and no longer in use, Waide Commercial Construction Limited is to advise CAA (Quote 2026-00334 to aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz).

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 15th May 2026 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
