

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Southland.

Location: 46 04 48.78 S 170 02 31.12E

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Nicholas George John Jackson Team Leader Aeronautical Services, having received from Stewart Family Assets Limited, notification to erect a wind monitoring mast on vacant land in Southland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The Mast to be lit and marked in accordance with CAR Part 77, Appendix B; and
2. The height of the Mast is not to exceed 125m above ground level (AGL); and
3. The Mast is to have marker balls fitted to the outer guy wires; and
4. When a date is known for erecting the Mast, Stewart Family Assets Limited is to contact Aeropath (Quote 2026-00488 to Part77@aeropath.aero) and request the Instrument Flight Procedures are amended, according to the assessment, and entry into the AIP and Obstacle Data Base is actioned; and
5. When the Mast is lowered and no longer in use, Stewart Family Assets Limited is to contact Aeropath (Quote 2026-00488 to Part77@aeropath.aero) and request the Instrument Flight Procedures are restored to normal and the Mast is removed from any AIP publications and the obstacle data base; and
6. When the mast is lowered and no longer in use, Stewart Family Assets Limited is to advise CAA (Quote 2026-00488 to aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz).

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 11th June 2026 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
