

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Smith Cranes Limited – Crane at Shed 7, Port of Tauranga - Position 37 38 48.6 S 176 10 59.8 E

<u>PURSUANT TO_</u>Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Head of Aeronautical Services, having received from Smith Cranes Limited, notification of intention to assemble and test a crane at Shed 7, Port of Tauranga from August 2025, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane shall be lit with an appropriate obstacle light in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B; and
- 2. Prior to the operation of the crane, Smith Cranes Limited is to notify Tauranga Airport and request a notice to airmen (NOTAM) is issued for the duration; and
- 3. Tauranga Airport is to issue a NOTAM for the duration of the crane operation; and
- 4. Where practicable, Smith Cranes Limited is to follow any additional conditions imposed by Tauranga Airport for protection of the Tauranga Aerodrome Obstacle Limitation Surface (OLS); and
- 5. When the crane assembly and testing is completed and no longer in use, Smith Cranes Limited is to notify Tauranga Airport to request the NOTAM is cancelled; and
- 6. When the crane assembly and testing is completed and no longer in use, Smith Cranes Limited is to notify CAA at <u>aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz</u> Quote 2025-01219.



This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 3rd October 2025 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
