

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 12 Selwood Road, Henderson, Auckland.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Nick Jackson, Acting Head of Aeronautical Services, having received from Radio New Zealand Limited (RNZ), notification of intention to erect a new radio mast at 12 Selwood Road, Henderson, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

- 1. The mast is to be marked and lit, as stated in the proposal, IAW CAA Rule Part 77, Appendix B; and
- 2. The new mast is not to exceed 110m above ground level (AGL); and
- 3. When the new mast is ready to be installed, Radio New Zealand Limited is to advise Aeropath (Quote 2025-00831 to Part77@aeropath.aero) to request the lit mast is included in the appropriate aeronautical publications and obstacle data base; and

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 3rd September 2025 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
