

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 131 Wairoa Road, Minden.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 7.7 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Nick Jackson, Acting Head of Aeronautical Services, having received from Fulton Hogan / HEB Joint Venture Limited, notification of intention to operate a crane at 131 Wairoa Road, Minden, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane is to be lit with an appropriate obstacle light at the boom tip as confirmed by email; and
- 2. The crane is not to exceed 64m above ground level (AGL); and
- 3. The crane is to be lowered when not in use; and
- 4. Fulton Hogan / HEB Joint Venture Limited is to advise the CAA (Quote 2025-00923 to aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane is removed off site and no longer in use.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 3rd September 2025 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 28th February 2027.
