

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Watts And Hughes Ltd- Crossing Building 4 Quest Extension Pakuranga Auckland

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Watts And Hughes Ltd, notification of intention to erect a crane at Crossing Building 4 Quest, Highbrook Drive, Pakuranga, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The cranes at the site must each be equipped with a flashing red light located at the highest available point on each crane, in accordance with CAR Part 77, Appendix B. These lights must be operational at all times; and
- 2. The proponent is to notify the CAA that the operation has ceased, as soon as possible after the cranes have been dismantled.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 25 November unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 30 September 2018.
