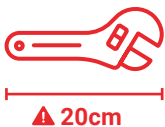

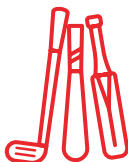
Before checking-in

To make your trip run smoothly, be aware of what you can or cannot take into the cabin. These items must be removed from your carry-on bag(s) and placed in your checked-in bag(s).

Do you have any of the following items in your **CARRY-ON** bag(s)?



Hand tools
**longer than
20cm**



Sports gear



Knife or
scissor blades
**longer than
6cm**



Tool blades with shafts
longer than 6cm



Remove loose batteries, power banks, earbuds, and cigarette vapes from your checked-in bag(s) and place in carry-on.
