**Rule objective**

The objective of amendment 11 to Part 19 is to implement the consequential amendments to the Civil Aviation Rules in accordance with sections 2(1) and 19(2) of the Civil Aviation Amendment Act 2007.

The following amendments to other Parts are also made in accordance with sections 2(1) and 19(2) of the Civil Aviation Amendment Act 2007:

- Amendment 34A to Part 1
- Amendment 3 to Part 140

**Extent of consultation**

This rule amendment is consequential to the amendments that have been made to the Civil Aviation Act 1990 as a result of the Civil Aviation Amendment Act 2007.

**Insertion of Amendments**

The amendments to the rules in this Part are reflected by the revocation and substitution of a paragraph, and the insertion of a new paragraph.

**Effective date of rule**

Amendment 11 to Part 19 comes into force on 26 September 2007.

**Rule 19.357(a)**

Revoke and substitute:

- “(a) The Director may issue or approve an airport identity card or other identity document in accordance with this rule if—
- “(1) the Director has, in accordance with the Act, made a favourable security check determination of the person who has applied for the card or document; or
  - “(2) the Director has decided that the person has undergone an alternative security check that is acceptable to the Director.”

**Rule 19.357**

Add:

- “(h) The security checks referred to in 19.357(a)(1) and (2) are not required if the person making an application for an identity card is issued with a temporary identity card approved by the Director that entitles the person to enter and remain in a security area when escorted by a person issued with an airport identity card in accordance with the security check process referred to in 19.357(a)(1) and (2).
