Rule objective

The objective of amendment 19 to Part 19 is to make corrections to rule 19.211 in relation to incorrect paragraph references.

Extent of consultation

A Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, NPRM 16-01, containing the proposed changes to Part 19 and other rules was issued for public consultation under Docket 16/CAR/1 on 2 June 2016.

The NPRM was published on the CAA website and emailed to subscribers of the automatic alert service provided by the CAA.

A period of 27 days was allowed for comment on the proposed rules.

Summary of submissions

Six written submissions and no oral comments were received on the NPRM. These submissions and comments have been considered and as a result a minor and non-controversial amendment is being made to rule 91.605 and two new definitions are being inserted in Part 1 to clarify the definition of “Instrument runway”.

No submissions were received in relation to the proposed amendments to Part 19.

Examination of submissions

Submissions may be examined by application to the Docket Clerk at the Civil Aviation Authority between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm on weekdays, except statutory holidays.

Insertion of Amendments

This Part was amended by updates to rule 19.211(a) and (b) to correct an incorrect reference from “19.209(1)” to “19.209(b)(1)”.

Amendment 19 to Part 19 comes into force on 10 March 2017

Part 19 Transition Rules

Revoke rule 19.211 and replace with the following rule:

19.211 Supplemental means GPS operations

(a) No person shall operate an aircraft using a GPS receiver that does not comply with the requirements of rules 19.207(1) or 19.209(b)(1) for navigation under IFR.

(b) When operating under IFR, a person may only use a GPS receiver that does not comply with the requirements of rules 19.207(1) or 19.209(b)(1) for providing supplementary information.
