**RULE OBJECTIVE, EXTENT OF CONSULTATION
AND COMMENCEMENT**

The objective of Part 61, Amendment 4 is to correct an omission in Part 61, Amendment 3. Part 61, Amendment 4 revokes Subpart H of Part 61, which was intended to be replaced by Subpart Q of Part 61, Amendment 3. Consultation regarding the revocation of Subpart H was conducted as part of the Part 61 Amendment 3 consultation process. The details of this consultation are contained in the copy of Part 61, Amendment 3 that was signed by the Minister on 16 October 1997.

Part 61, Amendment 4 comes into force 28 days after notification in the Gazette.
