Objective

The objective of amendment 5 to Part 108 is to implement the amendments to the Civil Aviation Rules relating to the implementation of the ANZA mutual recognition agreements in accordance with Section 41(1) of the Civil Aviation Amendment Act 2004.

This rule amendment is consequential to the amendments that have been made to the Civil Aviation Act 1990 as a result of the Civil Aviation Amendment Act 2004.
