#### Part 108 Amendment

## Rule objective

The objective of amendment 6 to Part 108 is to correct the creation of a duplicate rule number (CAR108.63) which occurred when Schedule 1 of Civil Aviation Amendment Act 2004 came into force on 30 March 2007.

### Extent of consultation

As this amendment is to correct a duplicate rule number and does not change the content of the rule, it is considered that consultation is not required with persons or representative groups within the aviation industry or elsewhere. There was however consultation between the CAA and the Ministry of Transport.

#### **Insertion of Amendments**

The amendment to the rule in this Part is reflected by amending the rule number.

#### Effective date of rule

Amendment 6 to Part 108 comes into force on 25 October 2007.
