RULE OBJECTIVE, EXTENT OF CONSULTATION AND COMMENCEMENT

The objective of amendment 7 to Part 135 is to bring into force changes that result from amendment 1 to Part 125 and consequential amendments to Part 1 and Part 119. Consultation regarding the amendment to Part 135 was conducted as part of the consultation process for the *SEIFR Passenger Operation* amendment to Part 125.

This minor amendment to Part 135 is to ensure SEIFR passenger operations are not permitted under this operating rule.

Part 135, Amendment 7 comes into force 28 days after notification in the *Gazette*.

Part 135 Amendments

Rule 135.1 is revoked and the following new rule inserted:

"135.1 Purpose

This Part prescribes rules governing air transport operations and commercial transport operations using—

- aeroplanes having a seating configuration of 9 seats or less, excluding any required crew member seat, and a MCTOW of 5700 kg or less, except when they are used for SEIFR passenger operations; and
- (2) helicopters."

135.3 Definitions

In Rule 135.3 the definition for Air operation is revoked and the following new definition inserted:

"Air operation means an air transport operation or a commercial transport operation, except an SEIFR passenger operation, using—

- (1) an aeroplane having a seating configuration of 9 seats or less, excluding any required crew member seat, and a MCTOW of 5700 kg or less; or
- (2) a helicopter:"
