Exemption from the Requirement in Civil Aviation Rule CAR 91.615 (a) (1) (i)

PURSUANT TO Section 37 of the Civil Aviation Act 1990,

- I, Graeme Harris, Director of Civil Aviation, being satisfied that—
 - (a) a review of airworthiness being conducted every 730 days on gliders certified under a standard category airworthiness certificate that are not operated for hire or reward, or in a training capacity, would not compromise the airworthiness of the aircraft; and
 - (b) the risk to safety will not be significantly increased by the granting of this exemption,

HEREBY EXEMPT—

Persons operating an aircraft

FROM-

the requirement in Civil Aviation Rule CAR 91.615 (a)(1)(i) that a person must not operate an aircraft unless a review of airworthiness is carried out in accordance with subpart D of Part 43 within the preceding 365 days,

ONLY WITH RESPECT TO—

gliders certified under a standard category airworthiness certificate, and operated in non-training, non-hire or reward, private role.

PROVIDED THAT—

- (a) the review of airworthiness for a glider has been certified and completed within the previous 730 days; and
- (b) no dual flight instruction, training or hire or reward is carried out.

This exemption shall remain in effect unless withdrawn in writing by the Director.
