Invitation to attend ICAO AVSEC Managers Course 6 – 14 May 2026

The Auckland ICAO Aviation Security Training Centre (ASTC) has scheduled the AVSEC Managers Course to be held as a regional course over the dates of 6 – 14 May 2026.

The Auckland ICAO ASTC, as one of the ICAO Aviation Security Training Centres within the APAC region, has a fundamental role to play in assisting States within the APAC region in strengthening their capacity building efforts and enhancing their capability to implement International Standards and Recommended Practices and remedying aviation security deficiencies. This is in accordance with ICAO's objective to support Member States in meeting their obligations for civil aviation security under the Chicago Convention, and to promote the strengthening of aviation security worldwide.

This AVSEC Managers course is seven (7) day course.

The course will be conducted in the English language. Please note there are no translation facilities available.

Course Goal

To enable participants at the managerial level to plan, coordinate and implement the application of airport security preventive measures in accordance with approved national and airport security programmes.

Course Objectives

On completing the course, the participants will be able to:

- plan, coordinate and implement the application of airport security preventive measures in accordance with approved programmes;
- apply basic concepts of management to aviation security and explain the specialist role of the aviation security manager;
- develop and implement an Airport Security Programme and associated Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs);
- develop and implement contingency plans, crisis management plans, and crisis management exercises



Target Audience and entry requirements

The target audience for this course should be at the managerial or senior supervisory level, primarily responsible for the application of aviation security preventive measures at airports.

Participants should work for the State's appropriate authority responsible for aviation security; airport authority for aviation security; other regulatory authorities, and/or other stakeholders that have an active role in the management of aviation security.

- There is no minimum level of responsibility for those meeting the target audience criteria.
